 - b) Future Plans, including field of study desired and the colleges or universities applied to,
 - c) A brief description of the history of the ancestor's military service.
- 2) Recommendation letters from each of the following:
 - a) Member of the clergy or community service organization leader
 - b) An educator
 - c) A business person or civil leader
- 3) Transcript copy
- 4) A copy of the qualifying military member's service record (e.g. DD2-214, Points Statement).
